The anarchists themselves called the dissolution "a deployment in the face of the enemy".

Anarchist ideas were brought to Japan by Kotoku Shusui in the very early years of the 20th century. He had read Kropotkin's writings while in prison during the Russo-Japanese War of 1904-5. When released he visited California, making contact with the militant anarcho-syndicalists of the Industrial Workers of the World (IWW), and returned to Japan to publish an anti-militarist journal, Heimen.
