1. Ependymal cells - nerve cells that form the epithelial lining, contains cerebral spinal fluid (nutrients), surrounds brain and spinal cord, assists in producing circulating and monitoring CSF  
2. Microglia- embryologically related to monocytes and macrophages, migrate to CNS, persist to phagocytic cells, remove

cellular debris and wastes 3.
